It also aims to advance capacity building by providing opportunities for aspiring young professionals to develop their skills through interactions with experts in their respective fields. In addition to conducting research, AIPRG organizes conferences and seminars designed to promote discussions and initiate policy dialogue on important Armenia- and Diaspora-related issues. By way of research and conferences, AIPRG collaborates with Development Agencies, International Financial Institutions, the donor community, individual researchers, and policy practitioners in order to achieve a greater understanding of the development issues related to Armenia and the Diaspora. Registered as a 501(c) 3 corporation in Washington, AIPRG has an office in Yerevan and unites over 40 Fellows from around the world.
